

BASIC GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

GEOGRAPHY STUDY TOUR TO ICELAND: EXPECTATIONS

1. Instructions issued by the teacher are expected to be followed **without question**.
2. Students are expected to be **self reliant** and **supportive** to other members of the group.
3. Students will **only** go swimming if a member of staff can accompany the group.
4. Students will **not be allowed** to consume alcoholic drinks (legal age is 20 years in Iceland).
5. Students will **not be allowed** to smoke **UNLESS** written permission is received from a parent/guardian permitting otherwise. Even then, times when smoking is permitted will be at the discretion of the staff and most definitely **NOT** whilst **travelling**; not whilst on **visits**; not whilst in **sleeping accommodation**.
6. On occasion, students may have free time (e.g. whilst in Reykjavik). During such periods they will be without direct staff supervision and thus must **exercise extreme caution** crossing roads etc. Students will keep in groups of **three minimum**.
7. Students will be responsible for their **money** and other **possessions**. **Great care** must be taken to ensure their security **AT ALL TIMES**.
8. We are privileged to be visiting a foreign country. At all times students must be **courteous** to the people they encounter and **appreciative** of **property** and the **environment**.
9. **Good time keeping** is expected.
10. Students must be aware that they are **one of a group** and that **we must all play our part** in creating a **cheery, cohesive atmosphere**.
11. **No student(s)** are to **walk off on their own** at any time.
12. Pupils will do their **fair share of all tasks** associated with the fieldtrip.
