**The CERN Laboratory, near Geneva
30th June - 2nd July 2010**

This year the Physics Department is pleased to be able to offer students from College One and College Two the opportunity to visit the Large Hadron Collider at CERN, near Geneva.

CERN is one of the world's largest and most respected centres for scientific research. Its business is fundamental physics, finding out what the Universe is made of and how it works. This visit will help to enhance students' knowledge and understanding of modern developments in Particle Physics. Whilst there, we also hope to visit the United Nations buildings in Geneva, as well as having the opportunity to visit some of the general sights of the city.

We will be travelling to Geneva by air and I am sure you will appreciate the need to secure cheap flights as soon as possible. The cost of the trip is expected to be approx £400 which includes all travel costs, accommodation (including breakfast) insurance and admission charges to the various attractions. Students will require additional money for lunch and dinner during the stay and some spending money. Full details and an itinerary will, of course, follow nearer the time.
