Dear Parent/ Guardian,

As part of the physical education programme for Seniors, we offer a weekly session at a local fitness centre in Haxby, which includes working on various up-to-date specialised weight training equipment.

As you may be aware, your son or daughter has selected this PE option for the forthcoming term, however, you should be aware that there will be a small cost involved of £3 per week (£27 for the term) which must be paid even if the student is absent for any session. There will be no charge for transport to and from the gym. With your permission, the amount of £27 will be added to your bill.
