

## College and the Activity programme.

### Expectations:

College	A minimum of <b>one</b> activity a week as well as Tuesday's Specials.

2. The Activities programme takes place between 4.30 – 5.30 for all of the school's pupils and is seen as a great opportunity for College to get involved in the school, to exercise leadership and to benefit from the activities themselves.
3. College pupils are encouraged to run an activity in a safe manner for younger pupils or for their peers. They may also choose to support a member of staff running an activity but they must ask the member of staff first if this is the case.
4. There are a number of opportunities in the Activities programme for volunteering.
5. Also we are looking for volunteers to help supervise the younger years' locker rooms and be a friendly presence in them as well as supporting younger pupils who have organisational challenges. Please see Lis Hooley, Head of Schoolrooms about this.
6. If College pupils are in school between 4.30 – 5.30pm but not in an activity, they are expected to be in their studies or the library.
7. College pupils are expected to be on time for activities and, if taking an activity, to be there before the younger pupils arrive. A warning bell goes at 4.25 and activities start at 4.30.
8. College pupils should change into their sports kit for sports activities.
9. School commitments such as sports teams, orchestra, choir, play rehearsals can count as an activity. The only condition is that it should be a weekly commitment.
10. Some activities have a charge. See below:

Fencing- Thursdays 5.45 – 6.46 pm Fridays 6 – 8 pm (£55 a term) Judo - £55 for the initial fee and £55 each term thereafter. Horse riding – Fri 4 – 6 pm (£16 per lesson) LAMDA –4.30 – 5.30 pm. £80 per term for tuition and exams.

11. A number of activities such as fencing, judo and horse-riding will need permission letters from parents or guardians.
12. If, for any reason, a pupil is not able to make an activity on a specific day a letter from home to the tutor to be copied to Sarah Allen ( [allens@boothamschool.com](mailto:allens@boothamschool.com) ) will be expected. **College pupils are expected to be accountable and proactive about any absences from the activity programme.** They will be expected to be gated if this procedure is not followed.
