Bursary Assistance from the Bootham School Trust

Bootham School offers means tested bursaries to assist children from low income families to attend the School (supported by the Bootham Trust). Applicants will be assessed by academic performance in the entrance assessment at 11+ and 13+ and in addition, for Music Scholars, their performance at the Music Scholarship audition. Assessments are carried out following the completion of a means test and the assessment process may also include a home visit.

Applications for bursaries need to be made in the autumn term prior to entry the following September.

Scholarships

Music Awards of up to 50% fee remission of a day fee are available by competition to suitably qualified applicants for entry at 11+ and 13+ (Years 7 and 9).

Sixth Form Academic Scholarships: Means-tested Academic Scholarships are available by competition to suitably qualified applicants for entry at 16+ (Year 12).

Applications for Scholarships need to be made in the autumn term prior to entry the following September.
